

SACRED HEART CHURCH, FLITWICK PILGRIMAGE TO OBERAMMERGAU, PASSION PLAY 2010 2nd – 6th September 2010

We took our scheduled flight to Munich and transferred to the Hotel Seeblick in the village of Bernried, which was voted Bavaria's most attractive village in 2006.

The next day we travelled to Fünfseenland, Five Lakes Country, where we had a full day tour of Bavaria's stunning lake district including Lake Starnberg. We stopped at Lake Ammersee and had a scenic cruise on the lake. We then continued to Andechs, a charming hill-side town with cobbled streets and visited the Church of Pilgrimage and the 'Heiligen Berg (Holy Mountain)'.

The next morning we visited Neuschwanstein Castle, the 'castle of the fairy tale king'. The shy King Ludwig II had built the castle in order to withdraw from public life but seven weeks after his death in 1886, Neuschwanstein was opened to the public and today it is one of the most popular of all Europe's castles. We then travelled to Linderhof Castle.



The next morning we travelled to the village of Oberammergau for the highlight of our tour, the 2010 Passion Play.

On the last day, we left our hotel for Munich and had a guided city tour.
