	<ul> <li>We have over 80 people with a current DBS.</li> <li>In January PB wrote to the majority people advising them of the new e-learning and asking for up to date contact details specifically an email address. There has been a very, very poor response. PB also issued over twenty DBS renewals and only three replied.</li> <li>PB has held back writing to the remaining people who needed their DBS renewed. In the last few days the Diocese has contacted PB. They have advised that although it is best practice and their policy that every three years we are to carry out a renewal of everybody's DBS they are asking us to put this on hold as they are short staffed.</li> <li>PB suspected as much as the two DBS she submitted in the autumn have not been processed. PB will now amend the letters asking for contact details and provide details of the elearning.</li> <li>Once this had been completed PB will have written to everybody who holds a DBS introducing herself.</li> <li>There is one DBS in the early stages with two still outstanding</li> <li>There are no safeguarding issues at the moment.</li> </ul>
