

## GLOBAL HEALING – ADVENT CONVERSATION

In 2015 Pope Francis inspired people to change their attitudes and actions towards God's gift of creation. His encyclical *Laudato Si'* was a heartfelt and timely call for us all to recognise our responsibility for the earth and how we need to act, now.

Inspired by this clarion call, the bishops of England and Wales have commissioned a thought-provoking documentary programme to refresh our commitment to the call to action.

The DVD features contributions from a range of people exploring the teaching of *Laudato Si'* and its implications for the world and all its inhabitants.

The contributions are sometimes hard hitting about the dangers of our poor stewardship of the earth, and what we can do about it as concerned and committed Catholics.

Our reflection will take place over three Tuesdays in Advent from 7.45 pm to 9.30 pm

**4 December:** The Deeper Conversion; part two of the DVD with conversation and a shared supper

## FEAST OF ST ANDREW 30 NOVEMBER

St Andrew, the Apostle was born in Bethsaida, in Galilee, and worked as a fisherman. He may have been a disciple of St John the Baptist. He became one of the first to follow Jesus and introduced his brother, Simon Peter, to him. As one of the twelve Apostles he was widely venerated in ancient times, and became patron saint of Scotland, because according to legend some of his bones were brought there and buried at the place where the town of St Andrew's now stands.
