### **CATECHESIS FROM FR. JERRY**

Theme: He breathed on them and said, Receive the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost Sunday is a celebration of the fulfilment of Christ's promised gift of the Holy Spirit and the commissioning of the disciples to proclaim the Gospel. Jesus Christ promised the coming of the Holy Spirit when the hour has arrived for his glorification (CCC#729). On this day, the disciples are thus empowered to renew the face of the world. The Gospel of John places the coming of the Holy Spirit on Easter day. Jesus appears to his disciples and imparts to them the gift of peace, joy, and forgiveness in the Holy Spirit. At the sight of Jesus, the disciples were filled with joy. The Church reminds us that when the Holy Spirit comes, we shall know him. The Holy Spirit will be with us forever. He will teach us everything, remind us of all that Christ said to us and bear witness to him (CCC#729). Surely, the power of his resurrection and appearance will chase away all fears.

As the Father has commissioned the Son to bring salvation to the world, Jesus commissions his disciples to be his messengers of forgiveness. Jesus commissions his disciples by breathing on them the power of the Holy Spirit. This gesture carries a deeper meaning. After God had created man, he breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, which is God's own life (c.f Gen. 2:7). In Ezekiel's vision of the Valley of Dry Bones, God's breath comes from the corners of the world to bring life to the dry bones (c.f Ezek. 37:5). The term 'Spirit' translates the Hebrew word, *ruah*, which in its primary sense, means breath, air or wind. On the other hand, "Spirit" and "Holy" are divine attributes common to the three divine persons (CCC#691). Jesus breathes on his disciples, recreates them, and brings them back to new life from their old lifestyle of fear and doubt. On the day of Pentecost, when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested, given and communicated as a divine person in its fulness, Christ, the Lord, poured out in abundance (CCC#3731). As a community, when the work which the Father gave the Son to do on earth was accomplished, the Holy Spirit was sent on the day of Pentecost in order that he might continually sanctify the Church (CCC#767). So that she can fulfil her mission, the Holy Spirit 'bestows upon the Church varied hierarchic and charismatic gifts, and in this way directs her (CCC#768).

During the celebration of the holy Eucharist, Jesus breathes on us the promised gift of the Holy Spirit, removing all fear and anxiety from us and consecrates us to be his instruments of peace, unity and forgiveness.
