# **CATECHESIS FROM FR. JERRY**

**Theme:** God sent his Son into the World...not to condemn the world...

How can we understand the mystery of the Blessed Trinity as 'three Persons in one God'? The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity celebrates and affirms the truth of the Three Persons in God who is the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Because it is a mystery, the Blessed Trinity is impossible to understand by reason alone. By faith, we can affirm the truth about the Blessed Trinity that has been divinely revealed to us and handed down to us through sacred scripture and sacred tradition. In order to articulate the dogma of the Trinity, the Church did not submit the faith to human wisdom but reminds us that God has left traces of his Trinitarian being in his work of creation and in his revelation throughout the Old Testament (CCC#237).

The Gospel reading reminds us about God's love that is revealed in the Holy Trinity. It is God's love for humanity, the motive for Jesus Christ to die for the Salvation of all especially, those who believe in him. God's purpose for sending his Son was to save the world and not to condemn it. Indeed, God condemns no one. God's offer of Salvation through his Son is a gift which must be received with faith, that is, by believing in the one through whom Salvation is to be achieved. As we celebrate the feast of the Blessed Trinity, the reminds us of the Christian family. The Christian family is a communion of persons, a sign and image of the communion of the Father and the Son in the Holy Spirit. In the procreation and education of children, it reflects the father's work of creation. The family is called to partake in the prayer and sacrifice of Christ. Daily prayer and the reading of the word of God strengthen it in charity. Like the Blessed Trinity, the Christian family has an evangelising and missionary task (CCC#2205).

May we confess our faith in the Blessed Trinity, the great deposit of faith for which we live and move and have our being.
