PARISH CATECHESIS

Matthew 10:26-33

The words of the Gospel today are directed by the Evangelist to the early Christian community as words of encouragement in their fear of persecution. Jesus warns the disciples that they can indeed expect to suffer great anxieties. They will be in danger from those who can kill them for their faith.

If they remain faithful, they are assured of God's protection, not necessarily here and now, but certainly in the next life'. Every hair on the head has been counted.' There is no real cause for fear.

Now the followers of Christ in every age should take his words to heart and proclaim the Good News from the house tops.

The reading ends with a note of warning. If the disciple does not stand up for Christ in public, but disowns him, then it should not come as a surprise if that disciple is disowned by Jesus before God.
