PARISH CATECHESIS

Theme: 'Anyone who loses his life for my sake will find it'

The Gospel speaks about the family. The church teaches that family ties are important but not absolute. Families must be reminded that the first vocation of the Christian is to follow Jesus Christ (CCC#2232). These are the words of our blessed Lord: 'Anyone who prefers father or mother to me is not worthy of me'. Jesus wants nothing to come between him and his followers. He desires total allegiance or commitment from his disciples or nothing else. Becoming a disciple of Jesus means accepting the invitation to belong to God's family, and to live in conformity with his way of life, especially in this changing culture (CCC#2233). The German Lutheran pastor, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, who was imprisoned and put to death by the Nazi regime in Germany, once said in his book, *The Cost of Discipleship*: 'The cross creates division in the institution where one is to experience unity. God's love for humanity means the cross and the way of discipleship. While most Christians are not called to die for the Faith, all must be prepared to bear witness to and suffer for Christ'.

Jesus promises his disciples that their mission will not be ineffectual. Whoever welcomes Christ's messengers (whether apostles, prophets, disciples or priests), will be rewarded with eternal life. To be worthy of that reward, one must take up one's cross graciously and follow Jesus Christ. Every disciple of Christ has a lasting bond with the Church, a sacrament of salvation, the sign and the instrument of the communion of God and humankind (CCC#780). May our lasting bond with Jesus in the divine sacrifice, bear fruit that lasts forever.
