PARISH CATECHESIS FROM FR JERRY

Theme: When the Son of Man comes in his glory, he will take his seat on his throne of Glory.

The Solemnity of Christ the King marks the end of the liturgical year. As the year ends, we are reminded about the end of time when Christ will come again to judge humanity. Jesus Christ is Lord of the cosmos and of history. In him, human history and all creation are 'set forth' and transcendently fulfilled (CCC#668). On this solemn day, the Church celebrates World Youth Day. The day is to celebrate the role of young people in the Church, to pray for them and to encourage young people to deepen their relationship with Jesus and explore various opportunities within the Church. Pope Francis encourages young people to reflect on the virtue of HOPE... 'Rejoicing in hope'! (ROM 12:12).

The Gospel reading invites us to use our imagination to capture a scene, where Jesus Christ, the Son of Man comes in his glory, escorted by all the angels, and then he will take his seat on his throne of glory. Matthew presents a summary of Christ's earthly ministry and teaches us how to care for one another especially those who need our care most. Some of us have the character of a sheep, where we could move out of our self-centeredness in order to respond with love and care for the needy while others have the character of a goat, who does not have the openness to receive God's overflowing gift of love. They are too concerned with their welfare, their status and prestige.

During the celebration of the sacred Mass, we reflect on how Jesus has cared for us in the eucharist through his body and blood, soul, and divinity. May we celebrate what we have become and become what we celebrate.
